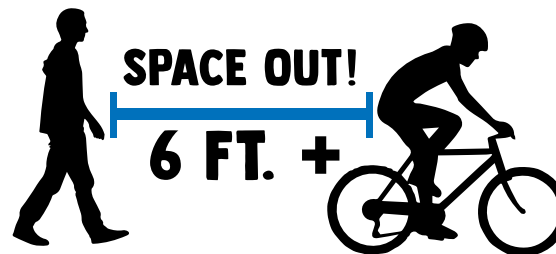

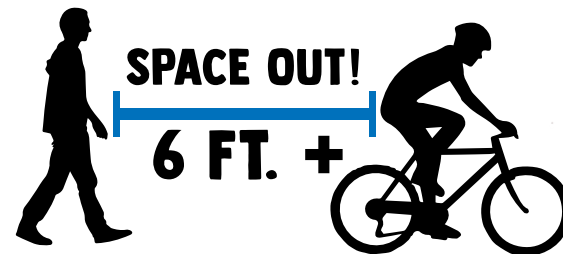

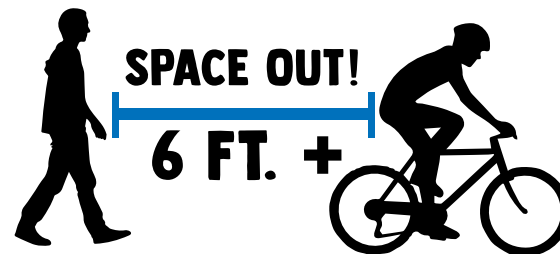
For your protection and the protection of all guests and staff, please wash your hands prior to conducting business inside the building and before touching any surfaces.

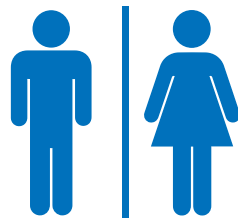

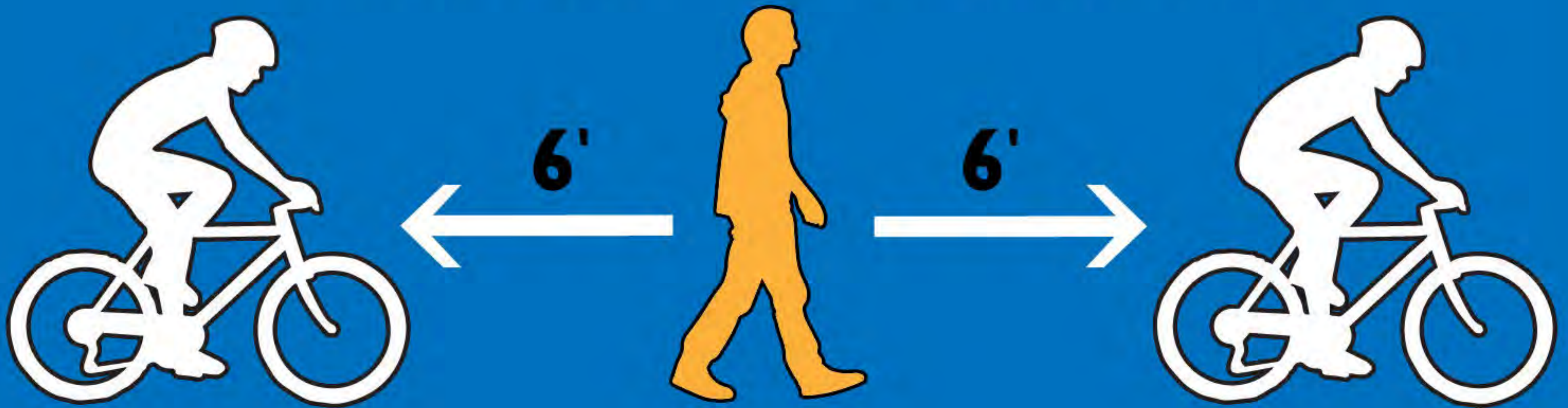

THE STORY OF THE WHITE PINES

The two majestic White Pine logs in the Grand Hall were salvaged from trees damaged in a July 2012 wind storm that took approximately 35 feet off the tops of these two giants. The trees were located on private land just a few miles from the Headwaters of the Mississippi, near Itasca State Park.

Both trees were aged at 136 years old, this takes them back to seedlings in the year 1876. When the trees first set their roots the United States president was Ulysses S. Grant. Minnesota had been a state for just 18 years!

When the logging boom was in progress at the turn of the century, the trees would have been too small to be of any use to early loggers, thus they were left to grow to maturity.

The two stump logs weighed nearly 8000 pounds each and contained almost 1000 board feet of lumber. Even though the tops had broken off, the trees still measured nearly 100 feet tall. The circumference chest high was over 10 feet.

The fireplace mantel was also salvaged from a section 65 feet up one of the trees.

Don Guida located and processed the trees and was proud to have been a part of providing the timbers and pine planking for this beautiful addition to the Detroit Mountain project.
